Step on guide complimentary for overnight motorcoach stays

Day 1

Arrive in Rudolph:

Rudolph Grotto Church - \$3.50/Person (Includes Cave)

The pastor of St. Phillips Church started to plant trees in 1919. In 1928, the Lourdes Shrine was complete. Set in a beautiful area of trees and flowers with man-made rock surroundings, the gardens and shrine provide a spiritual setting where one can spend quiet moments contemplating the wonders of God and creations.

Arrive in Marshfield:

Tour St. John's Baptist Catholic Church- \$2 per person

Built in 1878, this was the first church in Marshfield. The year 2002 saw a complete restoration of the building.



Tour Microbrewery and dine at West 14th Restaurant

Visit Blue Heron Brew Pub; the newest brewery in Marshfield. Sample the brews and enjoy fine dining upstairs at West 14th Restaurant. These two restaurants are located in the historic Parkin Place, which was a dairy processing plant built in 1941.

Arrive at hotel of choice for check in and overnight accommodations. A welcome reception with cranberry juice, wine, cheese & sausage will be provided by the Marshfield Convention & Visitors Bureau.

Day 2

Continental breakfast at hotel of choice

Arrive in Stanley (route will take you through the Amish countryside):

Tour the Stanley Area Historical Society Museum

Coffee, juice and ethnic pastries await you!

Choose two churches to visit:

- A. **St. Joseph's Church in Boyd**- Stained glass windows valued at 2 million created by German artisans.
- B. **St. John the Baptist Russian Orthodox Church**- built in 1907 features an iconostas, a screen of icons, which separates the church nave and altar.
- C. **St. Mary's Czestochowa**- Country Polish Church with a painting of the Black Madonna.
- D. **Holy Trinity Ukrainian Orthodox Church**- Wood frame church constructed in 1921. All furnishings handmade.

Optional Stop:

Shop at Broadway Home

Located in downtown Stanley, this store is a shopper's delight. Choose from a large selection of gifts or simply enjoy a cup of coffee. Specialty wines, coffees and candles are also available.

Lunch:

Alberta May's

The aroma will draw you in! Enjoy an ethnic meal of glombi (cabbage rolls) and perogie followed by bread pudding with caramel sauce for dessert.

OR

Cabin Ridge Rides (Cadott)

A horse-drawn wagon taken by Black Percheron draft horses will guide you deep into the woods to the cabin, where lunch will be served.

Arrive in Chippewa Falls:

Tour Leinenkugel Brewery

Enjoy beer samples and shop for gifts in Leine's Lodge.

Visit Autumn Harvest Winery – Open May through mid-October (closed on Mondays and Tuesdays)

Enjoy complimentary wine and gourmet food samples in the tasting room.

Visit River Bend Vineyard & Winery – Open May through mid-October (also closed on Mondays and Tuesdays)

Enter the tasting room for complimentary samples.
